**MONDAY:**

Proverbs 1:8-19

**FRIDAY:**

Proverbs 1:20-33

How does this passage point to Jesus; that is, how does the Scripture look forward to Jesus' work, or how does this passage bring you to focus on Jesus and/or the gospel?

**SATURDAY:**

Proverbs 1:20-33

What difference does it make in your life; that is, how do you want to change because of this passage?

**SUNDAY:**

Proverbs 1:20-33

Read the passage once more as you prepare your heart to hear it preached.



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
