**FRIDAY:**

Matthew 25:1-13

How does this passage point to Jesus; that is, what are people looking for in this passage that only Jesus can fulfill, or how is His divinity seen here?

**SATURDAY:**

Matthew 25:1-13

What difference does it make in your life; that is, how do you want to change because of this passage?

**SUNDAY:**

Matthew 25:1-13
