MONDAY:

WEDNESDAY:

To abide or remain means to continue in; what are some benefits of continuing to believe Christ in these verses? Which of these benefits do you realize regularly? Which of these benefits is more difficult to see in your life?

THURSDAY:

Psalms 62:1-12

How does the Psalmist emphasize the dependability of God in this Psalm? What does it look like to rest in and trust God? What makes that difficult for you? How do you see evidence of God's help in your weakness?

FRIDAY:

Revelation 3:7-13

How does the description of the benefits of those who endure motivate you as you finish the week? What causes you to lose sight of God's future and give in to uncertainty? How do you counteract your fear when it arises?

Galatians 4:1-7
