What fear in the disciples does Jesus address? When have you shared a similar fear? What do you tend to focus on when you think of God's guidance? What does God focus on? How does that impact your view of His guidance?

THURSDAY:

Ephesians 5:15-21

What does following God's will accomplish in these verses? How does that challenge the way that you think about God's will and His guidance in your life? How does your life evidence that you are following His will?

FRIDAY:

Genesis 24:1-67

How do the actions and reactions of Abraham's servant throughout this passage impact you? When have you seen God work in your life in similar ways that he worked in Genesis 24? How does that impact you?
