**MONDAY:**

Genesis 25:19-34

How is God's sovereign choice evident in this narrative? When has God made His choice evident in your life? How does God's revealing of His choice in the circumstances of your life encourage you to trust and submit to Him?

**TUESDAY:**

Romans 9:1-16

What is the basis of God's sovereign choice according to these verses? In what ways is that a comfort to you? What skewed view of God's choice leads us to doubt? How do your emotions lead you to doubt God's choice?

**WEDNESDAY:**

Habakkuk 1 & 3

Why does Habakkuk struggle with God's sovereign choice? What injustices have you observed that make submitting to God difficult? How do Habakkuk's words in ch3 help you humble yourself and submit?

**THURSDAY:**

Job 38:1-40:5

How does God reveal His right to sovereignly choose how He works? How does that reality bring you to the same humility that Job expresses in ch40? In what ways do you refuse to submit to His sovereign choice in your life?

**FRIDAY:**

Genesis 27:1-46

When are you tempted to force the hand of God's sovereign choice and try to manipulate outcomes? What does this reveal about our hearts? What does it submission to God's choice look like?
