MONDAY:

Psalm 2

What circumstances in your life drive you to rebel against God's sovereignty like those described in v1-3? What evidence do you see in your circumstances that God is sovereign and working His plan?

TUESDAY:

Matthew 21:1-17

What is evident that these people recognized from passages like Psalm 2? What did they miss? How does your repentance, worship, and submission reveal that you recognize Christ's sovereignty?

WEDNESDAY:

Revelations 2:26-29

What additional step of mediated authority from God is revealed in these verses? How does the idea of overcoming connect with taking refuge in the Son? What evidence is there that you are an overcomer?

THURSDAY:

Revelations 19:11-21

How does this passage illustrate the raging of the nations seeking to throw off the restraints of God's sovereignty? What attitudes in your heart reveal that you are guilty of the same raging? How can you submit today?

FRIDAY:

Psalm 2

Are you more likely to repent in wisdom or rebel in rage? How often does your attitude at worship reflect the truths of v11? What evidence exists that you have willingly submitted yourself to the reign of the Son?
